Good evening to all

It is with pride and gratitude that I present the School Annual Report 2025–26. This year has been a celebration of learning, creativity, and growth, where every day offered new opportunities to explore and excel.

I would like to present a brief overview of this year's notable highlights.

We take immense pride in the remarkable achievements of our students in the Class X Board examinations. All 38 candidates scored above 65% of marks, 15 scored above 90%. Mariyam Faris Nalakath topped the school with an outstanding 96.4%.

Our school proudly invests in the growth of its educators through continuous capacity-building programmes and workshops organized by CBSE, Sahodaya, and other esteemed bodies. Two enriching sessions led by eminent educationists Mr. Sunil D. Kuruvilla and Dr. Amal Thomas K inspired deeper reflection and professional renewal. An AI workshop was conducted to prepare teachers with Future ready skills.

Parents of newly admitted students were oriented on the 25th of May to familiarize them with our educational methodologies.

The new academic year began on 27th May 2025, marking a fresh chapter filled with enthusiasm and promise. To welcome the students, a special theatrical performance by renowned artist Mr Nikhil Das was organized. Subsequently, on 4th June 2025, the Investiture Ceremony was conducted.

Academic progress is systematically monitored through periodic assessments and two major examinations, enabling students to achieve their fullest potential in a competitive world. Regular PTA meetings fostered meaningful parent–school collaboration, and we deeply value the support and insights of our parent community. Remedial sessions were also provided to ensure that every learner received the guidance needed for growth and excellence.”

Our four-month long cultural extravaganza, Spectrum, celebrated the talents of students through 149 competitions across artistic, literary, theatrical, oratorical, and quizzing domains. The inter-school events reflected the dedication and excellence of our students.

At the Sahodaya Fest, our students shone brilliantly, Second-place honours went to Devananda P.M. (Class VII) in Mohiniyattam, Naina Nahas (Class X) in English Essay Writing, and Hannah George (Class VII) in Hindi Recitation. Third-place awards were earned by Amith S. Pulikkottil (Class X), Sananda Shaju (Class VII), and Haizin Abdul Naseer (Class III) in Digital Painting, Malayalam Speech, and English Recitation respectively.

Hanna George and Naina Nahas represented Thrissur Sahodaya for the State CBSE youth Festival and won 'A' Grade.

Furthermore, it is a matter of immense pride that all our students participating in the competitions organized by the Comates Circle, Kunnankulam, returned with prizes, reflecting the consistent excellence and versatility of our young achievers.

Evelyn Sone (Class II) and Ghanshyam V (Class V) made us proud by winning a second position in MTSE Examination conducted by the Thrissur Sahodaya. Four students qualified for the finals of ELPSE, the English Language Proficiency exam. Our teams participated in the quiz competitions organized by Federal Bank, in collaboration with H & C stores. Three teams qualified in the district level, and one team qualified to compete in the state level.

At the Sahodaya Sports Meet, our students showcased remarkable talent, winning a total of 13 medals. Special congratulations to Aarush P U, Evin Abraham, Sreeharsh Kumar, Khadeeja Amrine, Druva K Ranjith, Abigail Aju, and Reya Fathima K T. Reya Fathima further brought pride to the school by securing second place at the state level at the Kerala Central Sports Athletics Meet 2025-2026.

We had an enriching session on entrepreneurship in collaboration with the Willy White Toothpaste Company, offering Class X students hands-on exposure to sales and reporting through a practical marketing activity. The programme was both educational and inspiring, leaving a lasting impact on the students.

The school thoughtfully organized an enriching interactive session with Dr. Sureshkumar, and team consisting of psychologists, Behaviour therapist and special educator, providing parents with valuable insights into child and adolescent mental health. Parents were further empowered with the opportunity to opt for specialized counselling in areas best suited to the individual needs of their children.

Our morning assembly sets a good tone for the day through structured segments: Talking Books, Luminous Minds, Speeches on Selected Topics, Quiz of the Week, Quiz Corner, and Group Recitations. Talking Books exposes students to a new book every week. Luminous Minds highlights extraordinary personalities motivating students to dream big and aspire higher. These ensure measurable growth in public speaking skills.

Our school specially emphasises the importance of reading for an all round development. The Star Reader programme fosters a lifelong love for reading, motivating students to explore 15+ books annually. The Spic n Span initiative instils responsibility, teamwork, and pride, as students maintain classroom hygiene. Across the veranda walls, vibrant display boards serve as interactive hubs for curiosity and creativity. The quarterly school magazine, News & Views, showcases contributions from all classes (LKG–X), reflecting the breadth of student imagination, talent, and expression.

At Excel Public School, participation defines the spirit of competition. Sports began with the indoor games, followed by inter-house football matches and later culminated in to the Annual Sports Day on November 22nd 2025. The event transformed the playground into a vibrant display of skill and coordination. A total of 62 events ensured that every student took part at least in one event.

Our school commemorates significant days and festivals to instil an appreciation for culture, heritage, and their contemporary relevance. Celebrations such as Reading Day, Environment Day, Independence Day, Onam, Gandhi Jayanti, Teachers' Day, Children's Day, and Christmas are observed with great enthusiasm, blending learning, tradition, and joy.

Enriching outings, including picnics and educational field trips, added moments of joy and rejuvenation, broadening students' experiential learning beyond the classroom.

Experts from various fields interacted with the senior students online as well as offline. A career guidance session was organised by doctor Sureshkumar and team for the students of class X.

Agriculture is a hands-on component of our curriculum, engaging students in planting, harvesting, winnowing, fruit plucking, and enjoying organic produce. Our cows, goats, ducks, and hens are beloved companions, often surrounded by students during intervals.

At our school, education goes beyond the classroom, shaping both minds and character. The performances and achievements that we showcase today are a testament to the talent, enthusiasm, and spirit that define our school community.
