Teachers decorated the class-rooms to welcome their beloved students.

The thought of restarting cultural competitions, sports and other celebrations brought goose bumps to everyone. As the first step, students from Std I to Std X were divided into four Houses named after four precious gems Ruby, Emerald, Sapphire and Topaz.

The first House meeting was held on 1 June 2022. In this meeting each House selected their captains and vice captains. On 3 June 2022, investiture ceremony was held. Captains, Vice-captains and Prefects for the new year took the oath and received their Badges. Kiran P. Biju was sworn in as the school Captain and T. Ann Maria Saju as the Vice-captain. Aawaz includes recitation, speech, declamation, story telling, show and tell etc. This segment contributes largely to the narrative and oratorical skills of children.

May I inform you that the first unit test is scheduled to start on 4 July 2022 for all classes from Std I to Std X. The time table has already been sent through WhatsApp. The portions for each subject has been given to the students. Kindly ensure that your child has taken down the portions correctly.
